


ALPINE TOURING

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Check the condition of the trails and alpine touring routes before heading out.
- Refer to the markers on the alpine touring map and follow them carefully.
- Respect the designated opening and closing times for all areas.
- No patrol is performed on the ascent trails, even during the resort's operating hours.
- Stay visible and hike in a single file.
- Descending in the ascent trail is prohibited.
- Access to closed trails is prohibited.
- Alpine tourers are responsible for reporting any situation requiring assistance.
- Cell coverage may be weak or unavailable.
- Autonomous alpine touring (outside the resort's operating hours) is not permitted at Mont Rigaud.
- The resort reserves the right to charge a minimum fee of \$250 for any assistance requested outside its hours of operation and/or outside marked trails and designated areas.

RIGHT OF ACCESS

At all times, a right of access is required to use the trails. Get one online or at the ticket desk.



MOUNTAIN RECOMMENDATIONS

- Do not go uphill alone (a group of three people or more is recommended) and bring your own communication device. In case of an accident, your group may need to provide first aid, get help, and carry out an evacuation. Be prepared!
- In alpine touring, climbing and descending require different levels of physical effort. It is often colder at the summit. Make sure you are physically fit and wearing appropriate clothing. It is recommended to carry: a whistle, food, warm spare clothing, a first aid kit, and a headlamp.
- Let someone know about your activity (guardian angel). Tell them your departure time, your route, and your expected return time. Notify your guardian angel as soon as you are back.
- Do not leave any waste or trace of your presence. Be environmentally responsible!

DANGER
